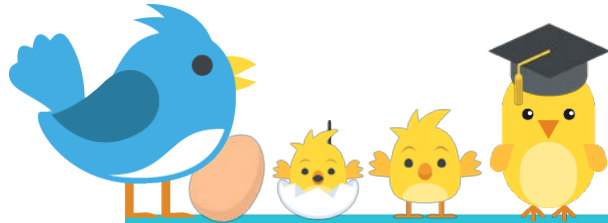

APPROACH

- Biennium investment of \$5.9 million
- Support CBOs, municipalities, schools and other nonprofits to provide opportunities for kids ages 5-24 in:
 - Mentoring
 - Youth Leadership and Engagement
 - Healthy and Safe Relationships
 - Positive Identity Development

Funding Specifics

- We expect to fund at a range of levels up to \$200k/Year for up to 3 years
- Year 3 of funding will depend on King County Budget approval
- Because we don't know how many applications and for what amounts we do not know how many organizations will be funded

- Narrative should be no more than 5 pages
- Signed Cover Page
- One Budget (please use budget template from addendum “Revised Budget Form”)

Criteria:

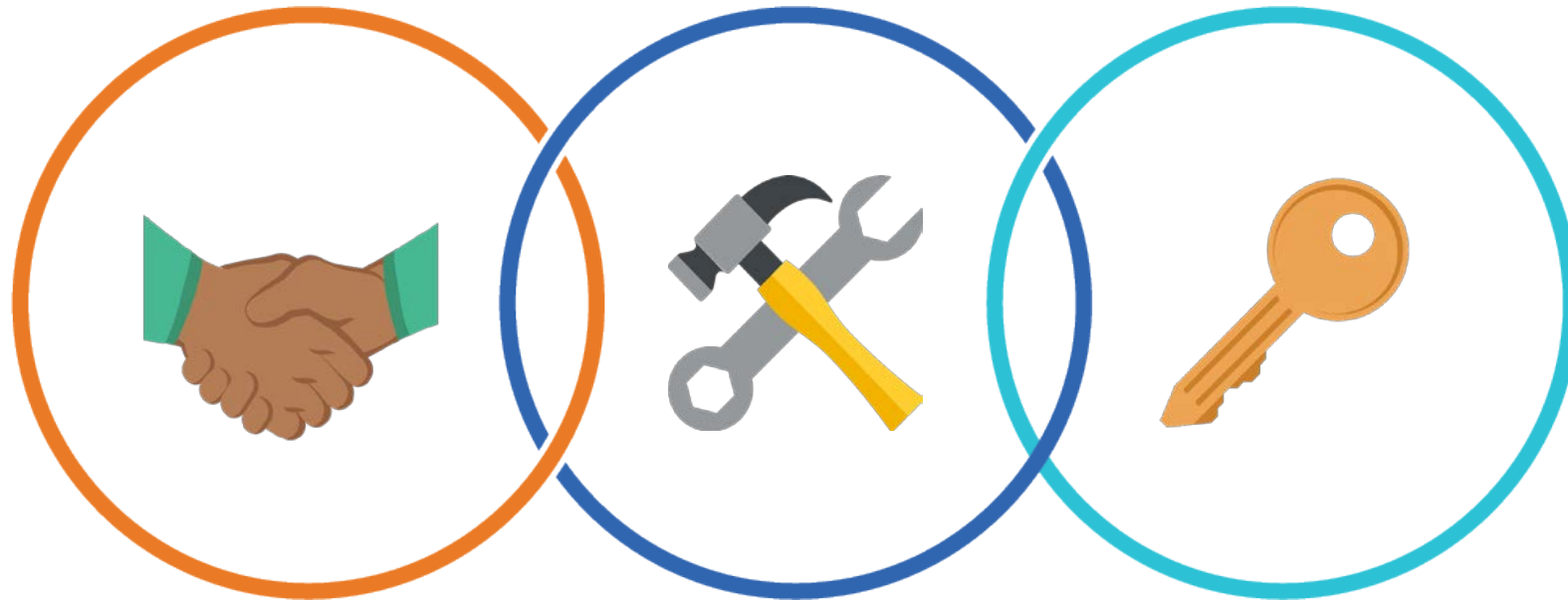
- Clear discussion/description of need

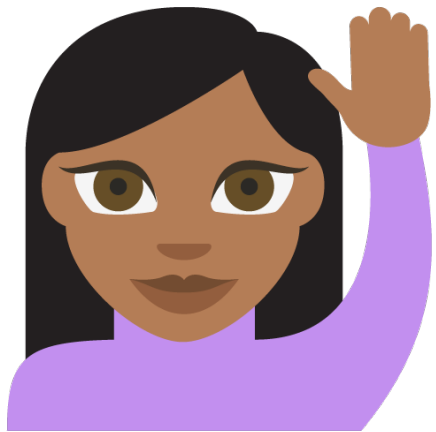


FIND DATA!

WHAT IS THE STORY?

- Identify **NEED** and **INEQUITIES** in the community where you plan to work.
 - Who? Describe population; highlight disparities.
 - Where? Describe or show on map.
 - What? How will you address this need?
- Show your capacity to meet this need.
 - Past performance (numbers &/or stories).
 - Information about staff, budget, etc.
