

THE RIPPLE EFFECT: A WORKFORCE COLLABORATIVE

What is a Collaborative?

Workforce collaboratives are coordinated, ongoing groups of providers made up of prenatal to five workers. The goal is to create space for collaborative participants to gain deeper content knowledge, build mutual support with one another, reflect on their work experiences and apply what they are learning to real-life scenarios with children and families.

What is the Ripple Effect?

The series offers foundational trauma knowledge for providers and highlights ways to share trauma theory with family members and across systems (e.g., schools, child welfare, mental health, medical system, judiciary, police) as we work jointly to lessen the impact of trauma exposure.
