—● **African Community Housing & Development**

Proposal description: New construction of a multi-use community facility for children, families, and elders of African Diaspora community. Part of affordable housing. Will provide a wide array of services.

● Bellevue Boys & Girls Club

Proposal description: Renovation of youth center to serve overlooked low-income and BIPOC children in Bellevue. Provide access to year-round recreation through covered



● Bellwether Housing

Proposal description: Planning, specifically design, of a community family resource center on the ground floor of affordable housing building. Partnership with FamilyWorks.



● Chief Seattle Club

Proposal description: Capital planning grant for feasibility (architectural design, outreach, site research and selection) for an urban native community center.

—● **Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District**

Proposal description: Renovation of a 49-year old community pool. Serving K-12, BIPOC and underserved communities with swim instruction and recreational aquatic activities.

—● Girl Scouts of Western Washington

Proposal description: Renovation of Camp River Ranch water system to promote water and fire safety.
Destination camp focused on serving low income and BIPOC youth.



● **Khmer Community of Seattle-King County**

Proposal description: Capital planning grant to cover soft costs associated with a community center serving the Khmer community.

—● **Martin Luther King Jr. Family, Arts, Mentoring, and Enrichment Community Center**

Proposal description: Renovation of multi-use community center. Black owned and operated, providing a very wide array of services to BIPOC communities. Hosts an array of organizations as well.



—● **The Arc of King County**

Proposal description: Acquisition costs associated with community center in ground floor of Mercy Housing development. Serves people with intellectual and developmental disabilities as well as their families and caregivers.

● Tubman Center for Health &



Proposal description: New construction of a community center, bringing families, children, and youth together around health/wellness. Site features include community gathering space, teaching kitchen, STEM lab, play area. After school programming for young people include health class, art therapy, mental health support groups and job training.

—● **Vashon Maury Community Food Bank**

Proposal description: Renovation of facility to expand services (i.e. classes, workshops). Partnership with Vashon Youth and Family Services. Serves low income, immigrant, agricultural workers. Bilingual staff.
